

The first couple who celebrated marriage in the Church were Patrick Dooling and Ellen Scannell on June 16th 1872. There were 8 Marriages after May 1872 and 7 in 1873, which resulted in 15 celebrations of the Sacrament of Marriage in first year of Consecration of the Church.

Since the Church was opened, there have been 1,570 wedding ceremonies in the Church.

In remembering and celebrating the 150<sup>th</sup> year of the building and opening of the Church we celebrate the people over the years who are Church.

Some of these weddings are shown in the photos that were sent in to mark this occasion. We congratulate all who are celebrating Marriage anniversaries and we pray with and for those who are having difficulties in their marriage and for those who have separated.
